Please be aware that the Southern California seminar camp facility is expected to be sold out this year. Registrations will be approved on a first come, first serve basis regardless of the deadline date. If you expect to attend this seminar please get forms in early!

Please note it is a requirement for all participants age 18 years old or older to have completed a satisfactory criminal background check PRIOR to attending any ICSL teen seminar. Specific details will follow soon from ICSL and will be disclosed on this page and the RSYouth.org website. You are encouraged to check the liability carrier of your center to determine their minimum requirements, compare them to the ICSL policy, and maintain enforcement of the policy which has the more stringent guidelines. Each Center's Senior Pastor/Spiritual Leader must authorize that such a check has been completed.

Remember, money and forms MUST BE RECEIVED BY the deadline date specified above.

SPECIAL NOTICES ABOUT THIS CAMP!

1. While it is the most sincere desire of the youth seminars committee to have every youth that desires to go to camp have that opportunity, it can't be emphasized strongly enough of the importance of timely registration. Much of the preparatory work for camp can only be done after all the registration forms are received, so late registrations create both time and resource challenges. Late fees apply for registrations received after the deadlines listed above.
2. Until both registration and fees are received no one is considered registered and they are subject to late fees if received after the due date. Late fees follow the following schedule:
 - a. Received after the due date - \$50.00 per person
 - b. Received 2 weeks after the due date - \$100.00 per person
 - c. Received 4 weeks after the due date - \$150.00 per person
3. Any registration forms & fees received after the above stated deadline will be waitlisted. Any registration requests received after that date will be approved only if resources are available. Wait-listed groups will be approved in order that their complete registrations were received.
4. All cancellations and requests for refunds must be submitted in writing to Rev. Keith Cox via email @ KcoxBH@aol.com or via fax @ 310.427.7140. ALL cancellations are subject to a fee of \$75. Any cancellation received later than noon Pacific Time, on the Friday, one week prior to the commencement of the seminar is subject to *no refund* and the expiration for requests for refund expires on the 15th day following the beginning the seminar. Any potential refunds are discretionary and maybe based on the contractual requirement and numbers reported to the location in which the seminar is being held.

5. Use of cellular telephones at camp will be restricted to afternoon recreation time ONLY, except for emergencies as determined by the camp Director. They should be turned off except for that time, day & night. The camp experience is designed to allow individuals to discover their individual uniqueness and interruptions to that process - such as telephone calls - are unacceptable.
6. Please instruct youth to drink water regularly. Most heat and altitude related problems we come across at camp can be avoided by doing this.
