Code of Conduct

ICSL Youth Seminars are dedicated to the purpose of self-discovery through the ever-expanding awareness of the indwelling Presence of God and the practice of the philosophy of the Science of Mind. The willing observance of the Code of Conduct assists in establishing and maintaining this purpose.

All participants of the seminar are expected to comply with the following standards set by the Youth Seminar Coordinating Committee:

1. Attendance is required at all activities and youth will remain in camp at all times.
2. No alcohol, drugs or weapons are permitted on camp grounds or in possession of youth or adults.
3. Displays of affection will be kept in the bounds of good taste usually accepted for public gatherings.
4. Bed check hour shall be observed by all.
5. Respect shall be shown for all public and private property.
6. Visitation of girl's dorms by boys and vice versa is prohibited.
7. The use of tobacco products is strictly prohibited.
8. The use of personal electronic devices for any purpose is prohibited with the exception of the time of day designated as "Rec Time" which generally starts after the afternoon workshop until dinner.
9. Ground rules of the host Camp shall be observed.

Any infraction of the Code shall subject the offender to appear before the Youth Council for appropriate action. As a participant in ICSL Youth Seminars, I agree to uphold the Code of Conduct as stated above.
